We care about your privacy and do not collect more data than is necessary. We process the following personal data: name and e-mail address for the purpose of providing our newsletter.

Your personal data may be disclosed to reliable third parties that provide us with administrative or technical support. If required by law, we may share your personal data with government authorities or law enforcement bodies, with external advisors and with other personnel who is subject to confidentiality obligation.

We retain your personal data for no longer than necessary to fulfil the purpose of the processing in question. Your personal data is processed on the basis of a legitimate interest, you also have the right to object to such processing at any time and unsubscribe from our service. You can unsubscribe below, but we hope you will stay with us! DEMOS addresses underresearched aspects in populism studies, and results will contribute to society in multiple ways.

You have the following rights related to the processing of your data:

- 1. the right of access to your personal data by requesting access to or sending copies of all your personal data processed by the Centre for Social Sciences as well as information on the processing of your data;
- 2. to demand that your personal data is rectified by informing which elements of your personal data are incorrect;
- **3**. *to demand that your personal data is erased; Centre for Social Sciences. has a right to refuse to erase data in cases permitted by law;*

- 4. to demand limited processing of your personal data;
- 5. to demand that your personal data is transferred by Centre for Social Sciences through the preparation and transfer of the personal data provided by you to another controller or to you in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format; only data processed under a contract may be transferred;

6. to object to the processing of your personal data

In order to exercise the above-mentioned rights, contact us using any means of communication.

The right to object

To the extent to which we process your personal data based on our legitimate interests - you can object to the processing of your data due to your particular situation.

You have also the right to lodge a complaint to a supervisory authority, especially in the member state of your habitual residence, your place of work or the place of the alleged infringement, if it is found that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR. In Hungary, this function is held by the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information.
